Spelling/Grammar Year-Plan:

- 3 weeks of WWW (5 words/week) per month
- 1-2 weeks of grammar (see long-range plans for concepts to be covered) per month

Mon-Fri 'word wall word' (WWW) work:

- *Monday:* Introduce new WWW (x5), discuss what is 'strange' or 'familiar' about each word, chant/spell out each word
- *Tuesday:* 'Using Words You Know' lesson
- *Wednesday:* 'Guess the Covered Word' (cloze passage, morning message)
- *Thursday:* Making Words activity
- *Friday:* Spelling Games (word riddles, crosswords, word searches, etc.) OR McCracken spelling lesson
